Phoebe suggested swapping posters around so that they don’t become ‘wallpaper’.</p>

Are there any improvements we would like to make?</p>	<p>Miss Craig needs us to complete a survey of what children think of our lunches. Miss Slade to create survey with group of school councillors and carry out in each class. Miss Slade to discuss with teachers on finding time to do this. Mrs Gibbs can present our final data professionally to be given to HC3S (by half term).</p>
	<p>Mrs Bolton’s list of things to discuss and take back to our classes.</p> <p>Discuss with classes.</p>	<p>Sand pit – School Councillors have decided they would like to trial a sand pit in the flower beds near the trim trail. Things they would like to have in the sandpit – buckets, beach balls, diggers, spades, treasure. They agreed that a monitor would need to be assigned and that the sandpit would need to covered outside of play time and lunch time.</p> <p>Guinea Pigs – can we use them as a reward? Tidy classroom award could involve responsible members of the class caring for the guinea pigs for the week (year 5 monitors to still clean out) so that they are a whole school pet. School councillors to discuss this with their classes.</p> <p>SOLE area – how much do we use it and do we know how and when we can use it? How is it used?
