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Dear parents/carers

As a positive case of COVID-19 has been identified in your child's bubble, we are required to send the year group bubble home. Your child will need to remain at home for the next 14 days. If at any point over this period, they develop a high temperature, a persistent cough or a loss of taste or smell, then please apply for a COVID-19 test and begin the 10 day isolation period required for anyone symptomatic (the rest of the household will need to isolate for 14 days from the onset of these symptoms). **Please inform the school if your child develops symptoms. This is important as we will need to inform PHE and further action may be required for the school.**

It is a requirement of schools to ensure that provision is made available in the event that pupils are unable to come into school and we would ask for your support in ensuring your child accesses the learning provided over the next 6 days. Their welfare and education is of paramount importance to us and so we have tried to make the learning as accessible as possible.

Daily Introduction Video

Please log onto the school website tomorrow morning at 9am. Your child's teacher will have uploaded a video explaining the home learning to be completed over the next 6 days (until half term).

Each day thereafter, children will need to log onto their G Suite account at 9am. A video will be uploaded from one of the year group teachers that will talk the children through the work that will be set for the day. We hope these videos help encourage the pupils to engage with their learning. All the information they need to complete the work will be in the provided resources.

G Suite

The children have their logins for this platform written in their home learning books. If you are unable to find these, then please get in contact with the school.

Each day, new learning and activities for the children to complete will be added to G Suite.

English

The English planning has been separated into several documents. Again, some optional supporting links and worksheets will be provided. The resources should be clear and explain the skills required, however a link to high quality explanation videos will be available. Please don't forget daily reading and spelling. Website links for these will be provided on Gsuite.

We will be setting daily Mymaths tasks as we were in the summer term. The Mymaths tasks have an interactive worksheet and also an explanation lesson. For each of the lessons, we will provide an optional video explanation link and an optional worksheet should you prefer something printable.

Foundation Subjects

Each week will have a different foundation subject (science, history, art etc.). A link to this work will be found above the table on the web page.

Your child's class teacher will be available in 'Google Meets' via G Suite every afternoon from 1-3pm ('Google Meets' is very similar to 'Zoom' but is only accessible through the children's G Suite account). They are there to help if your child needs support with something they found tricky in the morning, or to share something they have completed. Please note that it might be very busy at 1pm. If it is, and you are after some individual feedback, then please come back later in the session. We will also be providing a temporary email address for each class to submit completed work for feedback. This will be distributed later by the end of Friday.
