English

Year 3 are starting off the new year by being inspired by animal parks. We will use our best boastful adjectives and imperative language to persuade our readers to visit our own animal park.

<u>Maths</u>

This term, we will be revisiting and building upon the mathematical skills we learnt last term. We will explore deeper within fractions, measure and the four operations. We will also be covering the unit of time. Get your clocks and watches ready!

<u>Science</u>

Our first science topic this term is 'Solids, Gases and Liquids'. We will be investigating different materials and classifying them. After this we will learn about the water cycle.

<u>History</u>

The next history topic will be all about the 'Revolting Romans'. We will be building on our knowledge of the Stone, Iron and Bronze Ages to find out about the next British historical period. We can't wait to deepen our understanding with a variety of fun and informative resources and activities, including a visit to Fishbourne Roman Palace!

<u>Art</u>

In Art, we will be studying the work of African artist, Ephrem Kouakou. We will be focusing on improving our drawing, painting and printing skills to produce a final piece in the style of the artist.

Computing

In computing, we are going to be refreshing our e-safety knowledge including taking part in exciting activities on Safer Internet Day. With computers and iPads we will be creating videos that include a

PDL

During PDL this term, Year 3 will be focusing on making and keeping friends. We will be developing our social skills and learning about empathising with others. After that, our topic will be all about keeping safe in school.

<u>RE</u> During RE, we will be exploring places of worship including finding out more about the Synagogue and visiting one virtually. As Easter time approaches, we will be discovering how and why Christians celebrate Easter.

DT

This term, we will be learning about textiles. We will be using the Mengham problem solving wheel to understand, plan, design and evaluate a product whilst improving our sewing skills.

<u>Music</u>

This term, we will be building on our xylophone playing skills using a song Chinese Lanterns' to inspire us After half term our unit is called 'Mystic Moments'. We will be combining xylophones with untuned percussion to create a mystical piece of music.

To begin with, Year 3 will be learning how to manipulate their bodies into different gymnastic shapes, thinking carefully about their balance skills. Additionally, we will be building up our hockey skills so we can play a game of hockey.

Home Learning

All children have a home reading log and we ask that children read at least 5 times a week. In doing this, children will be in a great position to complete our termly reading challenge: to read 8 books. Everyone who completes this challenge will be awarded a free book of their choice at the end of term celebration assembly.
