

Year 4 Spring Curriculum Letter

We hope you have had a wonderful Christmas and have enjoyed seeing in the New Year!

<u>Writing</u>

Writing in 2025 begins with learning about what makes a successful discussion text revolving around the topic of superheroes.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths, we will focus on recapping our learning of time. Later in the term, we will be working on our multiplication and division skills in preparation for our times table check!

Reading

In guided reading this term, we will be enjoying the fictional books 'Charlotte's Web', 'Ottoline and the Yellow Cat' and 'Black Dog' before exploring the themes within our non-fiction text called 'What a Waste'.

History

This term, our History learning will be investigating the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England.

Computing

In computing, we will be focussing on being safe online. We will be finding out about online reputations and online relationships to help keep us safe. We will also be programming using BBC Micro-Bits and using this to carry out a project—Get off my Stuff.

<u>Art/DT</u>

This term in art, we will be learning how to draw things in proportion as well as exploring cross hatching to build detail. We will then use these skills to accurately draw dinosaurs. Later in the term, we will have the opportunity to visit a local art gallery. In DT, the children will be finding out about healthy snacks and how to make their own.

PDL

In PDL this half term, Year 4 will be learning about how relationships change in our topic 'Changes in Families'. We will discuss how families are the same and different, why they are important and what to expect from them. After half term, we move onto the topic of 'Ups and Downs in Relationships'.

RE

In the first half term, we will be exploring the topic of 'Belonging' and how the weekly Jewish tradition of Shabbat helps Jewish people feel like they belong. After the half-term holiday, we will be studying how rituals affect people's lives and the importance of the Paschal candle to Christians.

<u>Science</u>

In 2024, we will be carrying out our longitudinal study focusing on the question 'What happens to the weather throughout the year?' We will also be learning about animals and their digestion and how plants reproduce.

<u> PE</u>

To begin with, Year 4 will be learning all about the skills needed to be successful playing hockey and taking part in gymnastics. Later in the term, we will further develop our dance skills and introduce the sport basketball.

Geography

Our geography topic is called 'Looking Local' and involves a fieldwork project: travelling the perimeter of school grounds to investigate the types of houses and areas to live on Hayling Island.

<u>Music</u>

Year 4 love music and we will be continuing our learning of duration and structure with a link to our writing unit about superheroes. We will then have fun fitting rhythm patterns to a steady beat and learn to write our own music.

French

In French, we will be learning vocabulary to describe how to travel and how to say that we like and dislike things. Spring 2025
