We have completed our first term as year 6s and we are all very well settled into the top of the school. However, the fun has only just begun...

#### **English**

Our first unit of work for the spring term will be based around the poem 'The Highwayman' by Alfred Noyes. We will be learning the story of Bess and The Highwayman and using it to inspire our own writing. In guided reading, we will be enjoying 'Holes' by Louis Sachar, which we will also use as a hook to practise our writing skills. Towards the end of the term, we will be reading and enjoying another book by Louis Sachar called 'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom'.

### Maths

The spring term will consist of revisiting and practising all our maths skills. We will do this through continued fluency and problem solving. We will continue to practise our arithmetic skills daily in preparation for SATs. The year 6 teachers can't stress enough how important it is for children to be practising their times tables every day in order that children can use these skills to be able to solve a variety of other problems and calculations.

# Science

In science this half term, we will be looking at developing an understanding of evolution and natural selection including Darwin's discovery of the process. Next half term, we are going to have an exciting time investigating the forces of gravity, friction and air resistance inspired by the rollercoaster workshop at Paultons Park.
